The East Anglia Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes is a varied group of people including those who are sick and disabled, known as Assisted Pilgrims.

We need **volunteer helpers** (minimum age 17) to join us, especially **registered nurses** (for whom subsidies may be available), **student nurses, and healthcare assistants.**

Doctors and non-qualified volunteers are also welcome.

The Pilgrimage is open to people of all faiths.

If you wish to bring your family, there is supervised childcare for helpers' children (babies to age 16).

### Special prices available:

Aged 17-25 - join the Young Helpers Group for only £460 (coach travel & 7 days full board).

A few discounted places using hostel accommodation are available for helpers - about £500 including flight and all meals.

Some nurses may also be eligible for grants to subsidise their travel.

Registration as a volunteer or for the childcare programme must be complete by 1 June 2011.
