

A note on CA Hospitalité Elections

1. Vacant and soon-to-be-vacant Council positions (those which are not appointed by the C.A. Trustees) are usually advertised in Lourdes and on the website. At this time members are invited to send nominations to the Secretary of the Hospitalité. The names of candidates (along with their photographs and biographies where appropriate) are then advertised in the Autumn newsletter (November), which will be accompanied by the appropriate number of voting slips for each household.

2. Elections to the council shall be by ballot and the results announced at the Annual General Meeting. Members shall be elected for a term of 3 years and may seek reelection for another 3 years. This means there is an election each year.

3. However, if two positions are available, an election will be for one position that exists for two years and one position that exists for three years. In this situation, CA Hospitalité members vote for their first choice and then their second choice. The two candidates that receive the most votes under the first choice are elected. If there is a tie in the first choice then the Secretary will use the second choice as a decider on who is elected to the two positions.
